What is Ramadan?

A holy month where Muslims fast during the day.

What does 'fasting' mean?

Not eating or drinking while the sun is up.

What is Eid al-Fitr?

The 'Festival of Breaking the Fast' at the end of Ramadan.

What is Zakat?

Giving money or food to help people in need.

Where do Muslims go to pray on Eid morning?

The Mosque.

What is a special food eaten on Eid?

Sweet treats like dates or special biscuits.

What do people wear on Eid?

New or their best clean clothes.

What is a common greeting on Eid?

Eid Mubarak, which means 'Blessed Eid'.

Who do people visit on this day?

Family and friends to share a meal.

What do children often receive on Eid?

Small gifts or money called Eidi.
