Word bank: Ramadan · fasting · charity · mosque · celebration · gifts · family

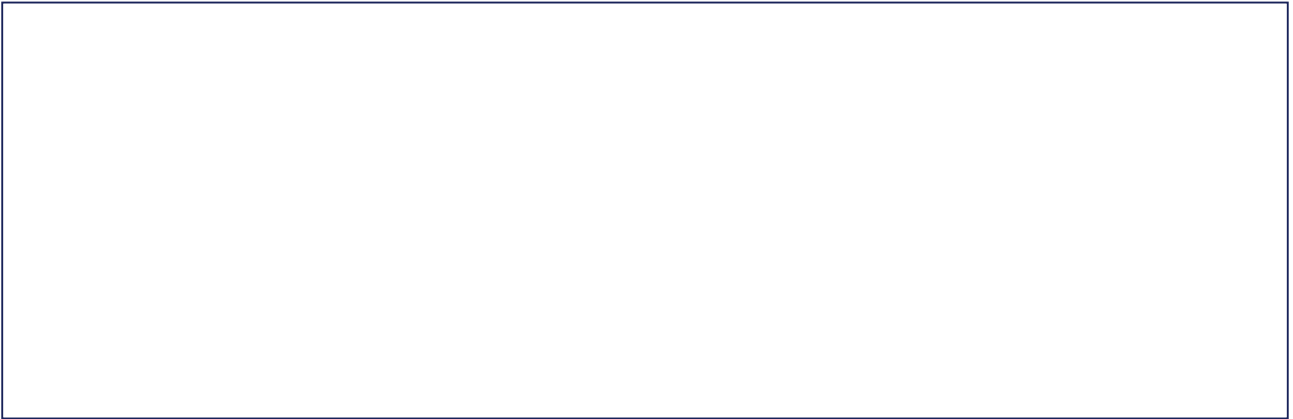
1. Eid-ul-Fitr happens at the end of a special month. What is the name of this month where people spend time fasting? (2 marks)

2. Why do you think families give money or food to people in need (charity) during Eid? (2 marks)

3. List two things that people might do to celebrate Eid with their friends and family. (2 marks)

4. People often wear their best clothes for Eid. Why do you think looking smart is important for a special day? (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of a table set for an Eid meal. Include colourful decorations like lanterns or patterns to show it is a time for celebration.
