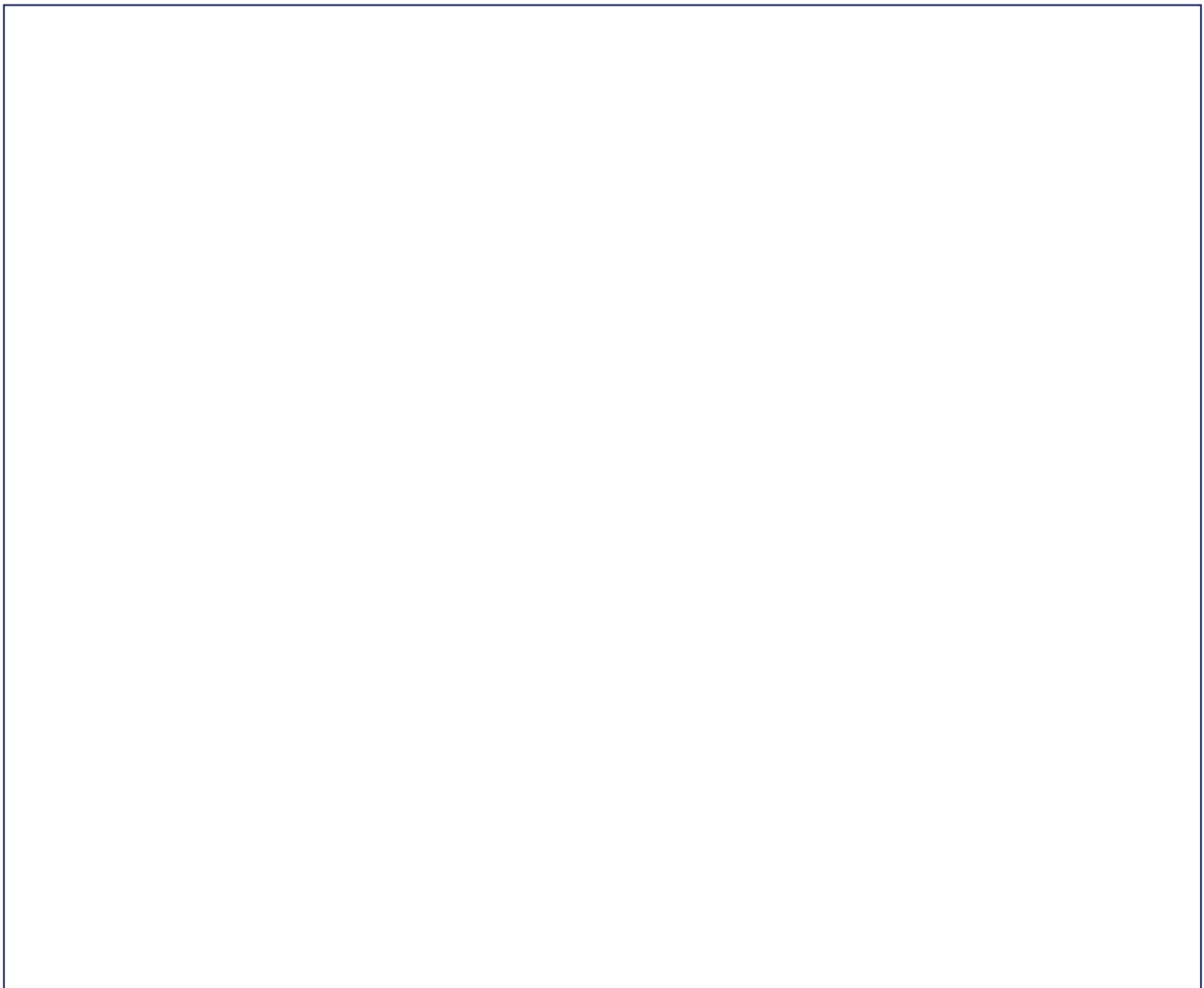


Making Kind Choices with Leo the Lion

Learning objective: To think about moral choices and how our actions affect others.

Follow the steps below to complete your drawing. Think about what a 'kind choice' looks like. Use the word bank to help you label your picture.

Draw: Draw a scene featuring Leo the Lion. In the drawing, Leo should be sharing a toy or a snack with a friend. Use bright, warm colours to show that this is a happy, kind moment. Include speech bubbles if you like, showing Leo saying something polite like 'Would you like to play?'



Label words: Kindness · Friend · Sharing · Choice · Respect

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw Leo the Lion in the middle of your page. Draw him holding a toy. What kind choice is he making? Write one sentence here.
2. Step 2: Draw a friend next to Leo. Show them sharing the toy. What does it feel like to share? Write one word.
3. Step 3: Label your drawing using two words from the word bank.
4. Step 4: Draw a sun or a flower in the corner to show that kindness makes the world a brighter place.
