

Making Good Choices: A Guide to Moral Questions

Think Big, Choose Kind: How do we decide what is right?

- A moral question is a question about what is right or wrong, rather than what is true or false.
- When we make a choice, we should think about how our actions might make others feel.
- A consequence is what happens after we make a choice. Good choices usually lead to positive results for everyone.
- Fairness means treating people with the same respect and care that you would like for yourself.
- Asking for advice from a trusted friend or teacher can help us see a problem from a different point of view.

Did you know? Did you know? Many people look at their 'values' to help them make tricky decisions. Values are the important beliefs that guide us, like honesty, bravery, and friendship. When we face a moral question, we are really asking: 'What is the kindest way to act?'
