

Remembering with Leo the Lion

Learning objective: To understand the significance of Remembrance Day as a time to show respect and think about peace.

Leo the Lion is writing a poem about peace and kindness. Look at the words in the word bank. Sort them into two groups: things that help us feel peaceful and happy (Peace), and things that help us remember people who were brave (Remembrance). Write the words in the correct column on your sheet.

Word bank: Poppy · Smile · Silence · Kindness · Friendship · Medal

1. Why do we wear a bright red poppy on our clothes in November? (2 marks)

2. When we have a minute of silence, what are we doing with our voices? (2 marks)

3. Can you name one way you can be kind to a friend today? (2 marks)

4. Is the poppy a symbol of sadness or a symbol of remembering? (2 marks)

5. Why is it important to say 'thank you' to people who keep us safe? (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a field of bright red poppies with a peaceful blue sky above. Add a golden sun to represent a bright, hopeful future.



Extension challenge: Talk with your family about someone special you like to remember. Draw a picture of them or find a photograph to share with your class.
