

Remembering with Leo the Lion

Learning objective: To understand the meaning of Remembrance Day through reflection and artistic expression.

Today, we are thinking about Remembrance Day. Leo the Lion is reflecting on the importance of peace and remembering the people who have helped us. Follow the steps below to create your own commemorative picture.

Draw: Draw a scene featuring a large, bright red poppy as the central focus. Use bold, clear lines. Around the poppy, include elements that represent peace, such as a gentle sun, soft grass, or a blue sky. The style should be bright and respectful, using crayons or coloured pencils. Include Leo the Lion standing near the poppy, looking thoughtful and kind.



Label words: Poppy · Peace · Remembrance · Red · Friendship

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a large, bright red poppy in the middle of your page. What shape are the petals?
2. Step 2: Leo the Lion likes to write poems about peace. Can you draw a peaceful sun or a dove in the corner of your picture?
3. Step 3: Label your drawing using at least two words from the word bank provided above.
4. Step 4: Why do we wear a poppy on Remembrance Day? Tell a partner or your teacher.

5. Step 5: If you were giving a poppy to a friend to show kindness, what colour would you colour the stem and leaves?
