

Leo the Lion's Remembrance Fact-File

Learning objective: To understand the importance of Remembrance Day and why we show respect for those who helped us.

Today, Leo the Lion is learning about why we wear poppies in November. Use this fact-file to write down what you have learned about this special day. You can draw a picture in the box to show how we remember.

Word bank: Poppy · Remember · Respect · Peace · Red · Thank you

1. The Poppy: Why do we wear a bright red poppy on our clothes? (2 marks)

2. Showing Respect: How can we show that we are thinking about others on Remembrance Day? (2 marks)

3. A Quiet Moment: What does it mean to have a 'silence' to remember people? (2 marks)

4. Helping Others: Who are some people in our community who help us keep safe today? (2 marks)

5. My Message: If you could say one 'thank you' to someone who helps us, what would you say? (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of a field of poppies or something that makes you think of peace.



Extension challenge: Talk to an adult at home about a family member who has helped others, and write their name in your book.
