

Nova's Digestive System Sketchbook

Learning objective: To identify and label the parts of the human digestive system.

Follow the steps below to draw and label the human digestive system. Use the word bank to help you label each part correctly.

Draw: Draw a clear, simple diagram of the human digestive system inside a human body outline. Use different colours for each part: blue for the mouth, red for the oesophagus, yellow for the stomach, green for the small intestine, and purple for the large intestine. Make sure the labels point clearly to each section.



Label words: Mouth · Oesophagus · Stomach · Small intestine · Large intestine

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a simple outline of a person. Inside the body, draw the tube that carries food from the mouth to the stomach. Label it 'Oesophagus'.
2. Step 2: Draw a pouch shape for the stomach. Label it 'Stomach'.
3. Step 3: Draw a long, winding tube connected to the stomach. Label it 'Small intestine'.
4. Step 4: Draw a wider tube around the outside of the small intestine. Label it 'Large intestine'.
