

Nova's Autumn Discovery Hunt

Learning objective: To observe and describe the changing features of the natural world during the autumn season.

Help Nova the owl explore the woods! Look at the trees and the ground. Use your pencils to draw what you see during autumn. Use the word bank to label your beautiful picture.

Draw: Create a scene featuring a tall, friendly-looking oak tree. The ground should be covered in fallen leaves of different shapes. In the sky, draw a small, curious owl (Nova) looking down at the forest floor. Use warm autumn colours like red, orange, yellow, and brown for the leaves. The style should be bright, inviting, and simple for a child to replicate.



Label words: leaf · acorn · tree · brown · orange

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a big tree in the middle of your page. Can you draw some leaves falling down from the branches?
2. Step 2: Draw two orange leaves and two brown leaves on the ground. How many leaves are there altogether?
3. Step 3: Draw a little acorn sitting near the tree. Does it look smooth or bumpy?
4. Step 4: Label your drawing using the words from the word bank.

5. Step 5: Nova the owl wants to know what colour the leaves turn in autumn. Can you write the colour name?
