

Autumn Discovery with Nova the Owl

Learning objective: To observe and identify the signs of autumn in the natural world.

Follow the steps below to draw your autumn scene. Use your best colouring pencils to show the colours of the season.

Draw: Draw a woodland scene in autumn. Include a large tree with colourful leaves, a pile of brown leaves on the grass, a shiny brown conker, a small acorn, birds flying in the distance, and a small hole at the base of the tree for a hibernating animal. Use warm colours like red, orange, and gold for the leaves.



Label words: deciduous tree · fallen leaves · conker · acorn · migration · hibernation

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a large deciduous tree in the centre of your page. Make sure its leaves are orange, yellow, or brown. Label your tree.
2. Step 2: Draw some fallen leaves on the ground near the tree. Add one conker and one acorn next to them.
3. Step 3: Nova the Owl is watching the sky. Draw two birds flying south in the sky. Write 'migration' next to them.
4. Step 4: Draw a small hole at the bottom of your tree trunk. This is where a hedgehog might hide. Write 'hibernation' near the hole.
