- Some birds fly to warmer countries to find food, which is called migration.
- The days become shorter in autumn because the Earth is tilting away from the sun.
- Fungi and mushrooms grow quickly in the damp, cool autumn air.

Did you know? Did you know? Trees change colour because they stop making chlorophyll, which is the green stuff they use to make food from sunlight. Without it, the hidden reds and oranges of the leaves finally show through!
