Learning objective: To identify and describe the functions of different parts of the human digestive system.

Bea the honeybee needs your help to label the path that food takes through the body. Look at the boxes below and match the body part to what it does. Draw a line from the body part to the correct description.

1. 1. I am where food is chewed and broken into smaller pieces. Which part am I? (Draw a line or write the name here): (2 marks)

2. 2. I am a long tube that pushes food down to the stomach. Which part am I? (Write the name): (2 marks)

3. 3. I am a bag that mixes food with special juices. Which part am I? (Write the name): (2 marks)

4. 4. I soak up all the goodness (nutrients) from the food into the body. Which part am I? (Write the name): (2 marks)

5. 5. I take the water out of the waste before it leaves the body. Which part am I? (Write the name): (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a simple outline of a human body and draw a wiggly line inside to show the path food takes from the mouth down to the stomach.



Extension challenge: Can you put these in the right order? Number them 1 to 5: Stomach, Mouth, Large Intestine, Oesophagus, Small Intestine.
