

Bea's Digestive Journey

Learning objective: To identify and label the parts of the human digestive system.

Follow the steps below to complete your diagram of the digestive system. Use your pencil to draw clearly and add labels using the words in the bank.

Draw: Draw a large, simple outline of a human body in the centre of the page. Inside the body, draw the path food takes. Use simple shapes: a small circle for the mouth, a long line for the oesophagus, a bean shape for the stomach, a coiled line for the small intestine, and a thick frame shape for the large intestine.



Label words: Mouth · Oesophagus · Stomach · Small Intestine · Large Intestine

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw the shape of the stomach in the centre of the body outline. Label the stomach.
2. Step 2: Draw a long tube connecting the mouth to the stomach. Label this the oesophagus.
3. Step 3: Draw a wiggly tube below the stomach for the small intestine. Label it.
4. Step 4: Draw a wider tube around the outside of the small intestine. Label this the large intestine.
