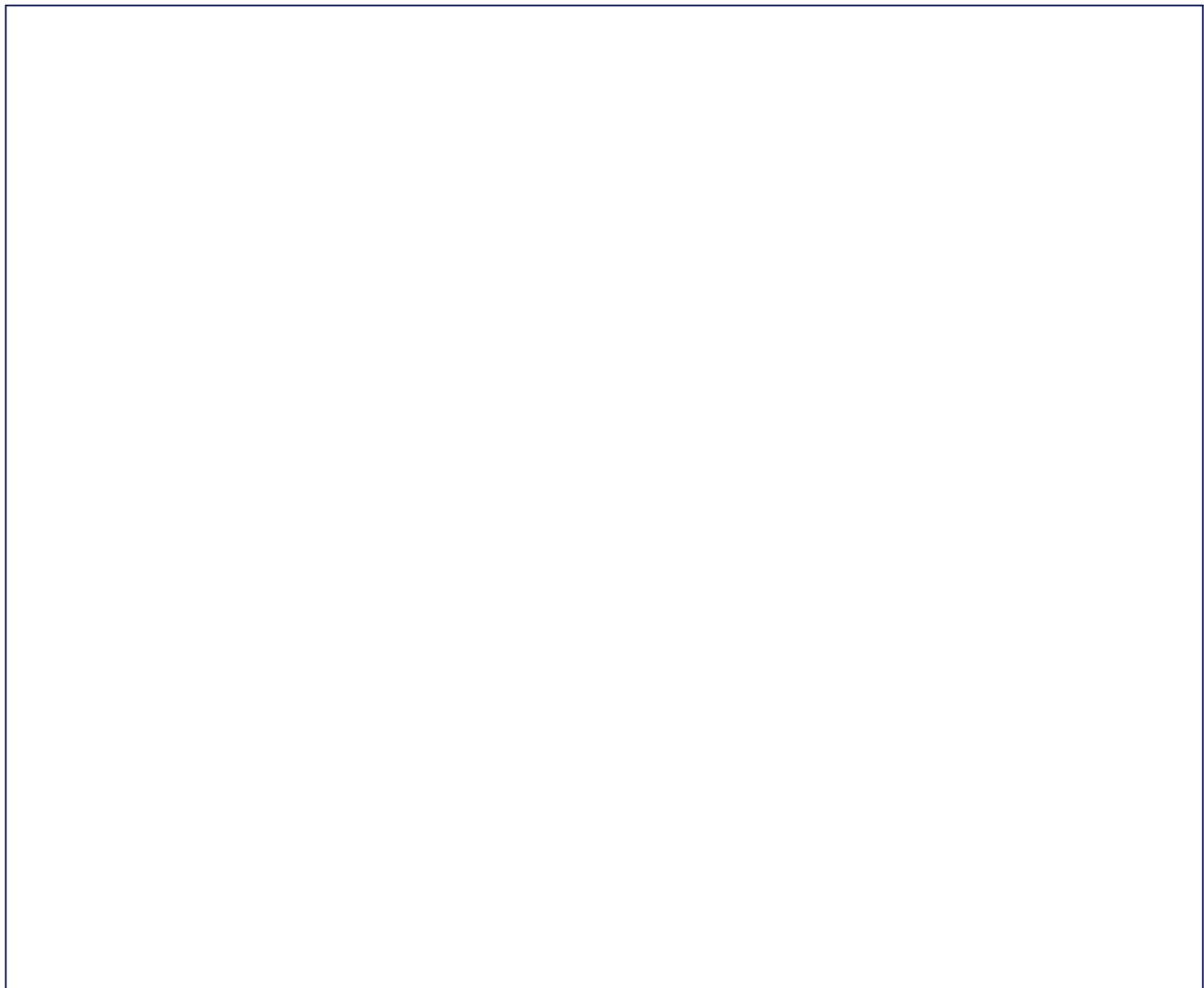


Bea's Garden Food Chain Drawing Sheet

Learning objective: To identify and draw a simple food chain showing how energy passes from a producer to consumers.

Follow the steps below to draw a food chain. Use the word bank to help you label each part of your drawing. Remember to draw arrows to show the direction of the energy flow.

Draw: Draw a bright, sunny garden scene. On the left, draw a large yellow sun and a bright green leafy plant. In the middle, draw a small caterpillar on a leaf. On the right, draw a friendly garden bird. Use arrows to connect the sun to the plant, the plant to the caterpillar, and the caterpillar to the bird.



Label words: Producer · Herbivore · Carnivore · Sun · Energy

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw the Sun in the corner. Then, draw a green plant. Label the plant as the 'Producer'.
2. Step 2: Draw a caterpillar eating the plant. Label the caterpillar as a 'Herbivore'.
3. Step 3: Draw a bird that eats the caterpillar. Label the bird as a 'Carnivore'.
4. Step 4: Draw arrows between each living thing. What do the arrows show? (Sentence starter: The arrows show the flow of...)
