

Nova's Amazing Body Lab

Learning objective: To identify and name parts of the human digestive system and understand their basic functions.

Help Nova the owl map the journey of food! Draw a line to match each body part to its job. Then, write the name of the organ next to the correct description. Use the word bank to help you.

Word bank: Mouth · Stomach · Small Intestine · Oesophagus

1. 1. I am where the food starts its journey. I chew the food into smaller pieces. Which part am I? (2 marks)

2. 2. I am a long tube that carries food from the mouth down to the stomach. Which part am I? (2 marks)

3. 3. I am a bag that mixes food with juices to break it down further. Which part am I? (2 marks)

4. 4. I am where the body takes all the good nutrients from the food. Which part am I? (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a simple outline of a person and label the mouth, the tube going down to the tummy, the stomach, and the intestines.



Extension challenge: Nova wants to know: Why do we need to chew our food well before we swallow it? Write one sentence.
