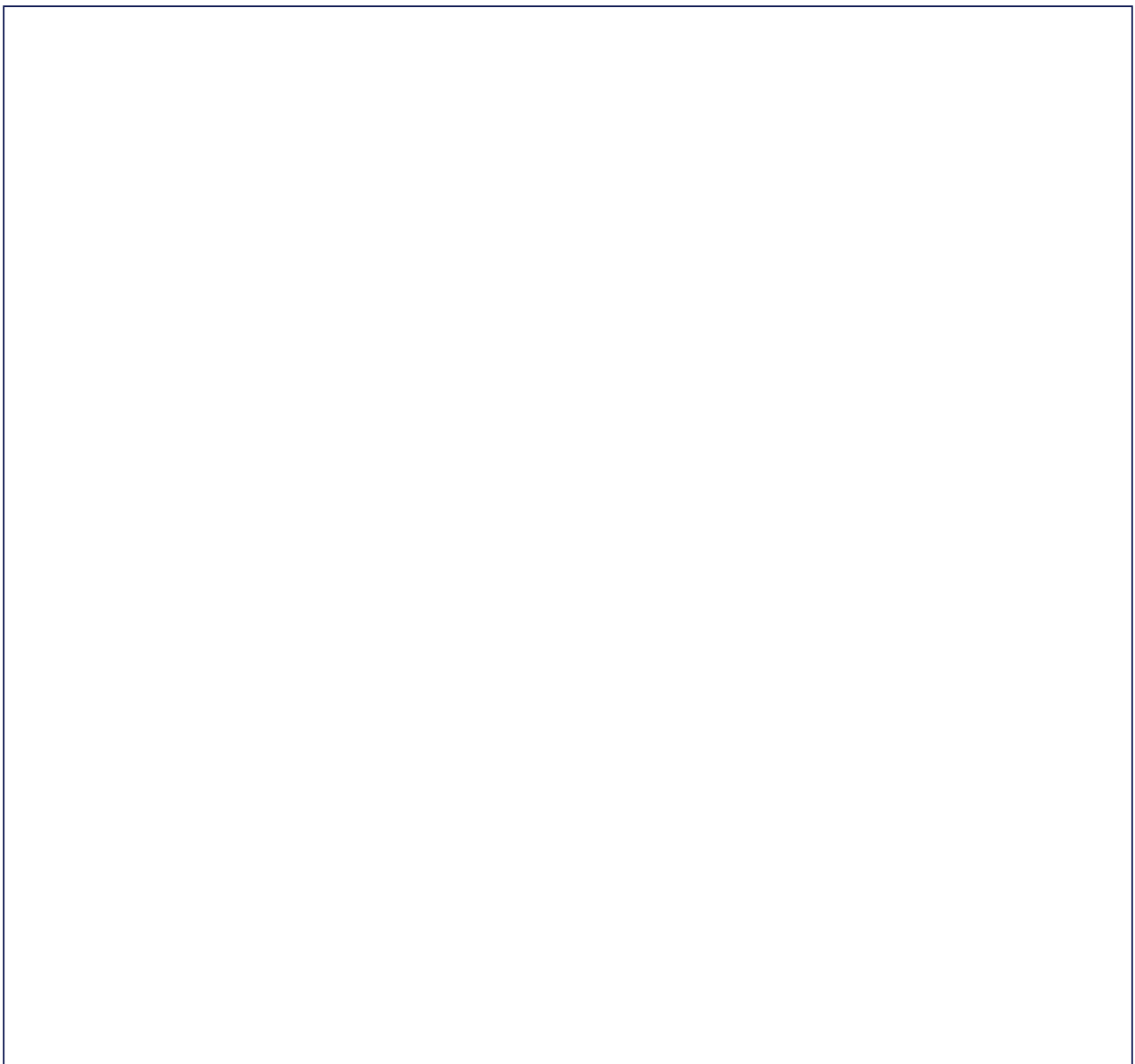


Bea's Beautiful Garden

Learning objective: To identify and name the basic parts of a plant and understand how they grow.

Help Bea the honeybee explore the garden! Colour in the plant and use the labels to show the different parts. Talk to a grown-up about what plants need to grow big and strong.

Colour this: A large, friendly-looking sunflower in the centre of the page with a thick stem and two large leaves. There are roots visible underground at the bottom of the page. Steps:

1. Label the root at the bottom of the plant.
