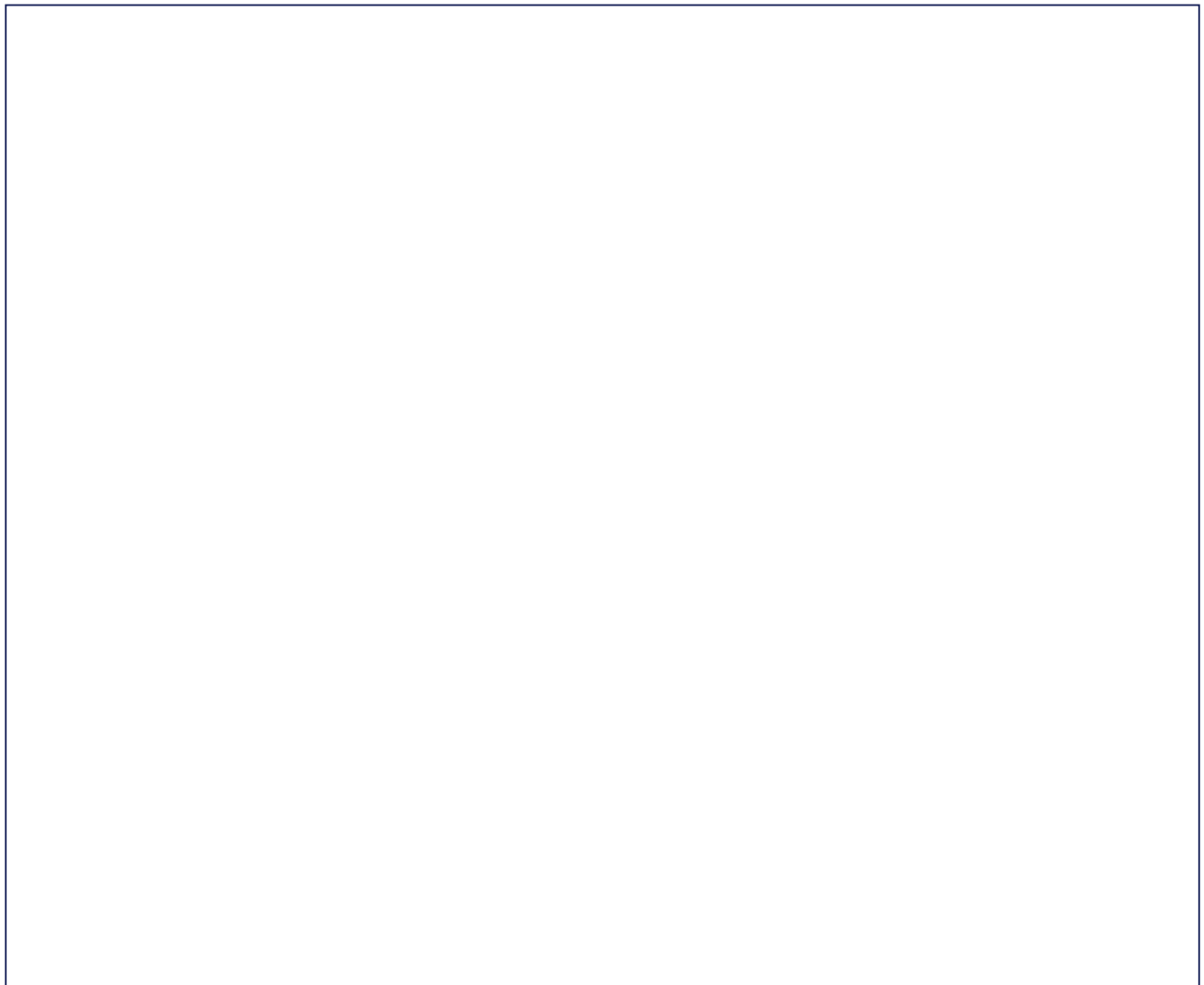


Nova's Material Investigation

Learning objective: To identify and describe the properties of materials used to build objects.

Help Nova the owl explore the garden! Follow the steps below to draw and label the objects Nova finds. Use the word bank to help you.

Draw: Draw a sunny garden scene. Include a small wooden shed with a glass window, a metal spade leaning against the wall, a pair of rubber gloves on a bench, and a soft woolly scarf hanging on a post. Keep the lines clear and simple so you have space to add your labels next to each object.



Label words: transparent · waterproof · flexible · hard · rough · smooth

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a glass window on a shed. Label it using the word from the bank that means you can see through it.
2. Step 2: Draw a metal spade. Label it with the word from the bank that describes its strength.
3. Step 3: Draw a pair of rubber gloves. Label them with the word from the bank that describes how they stop water getting in.
4. Step 4: Draw a woolly scarf. Label it with the word from the bank that describes why it can be wrapped around a neck.
