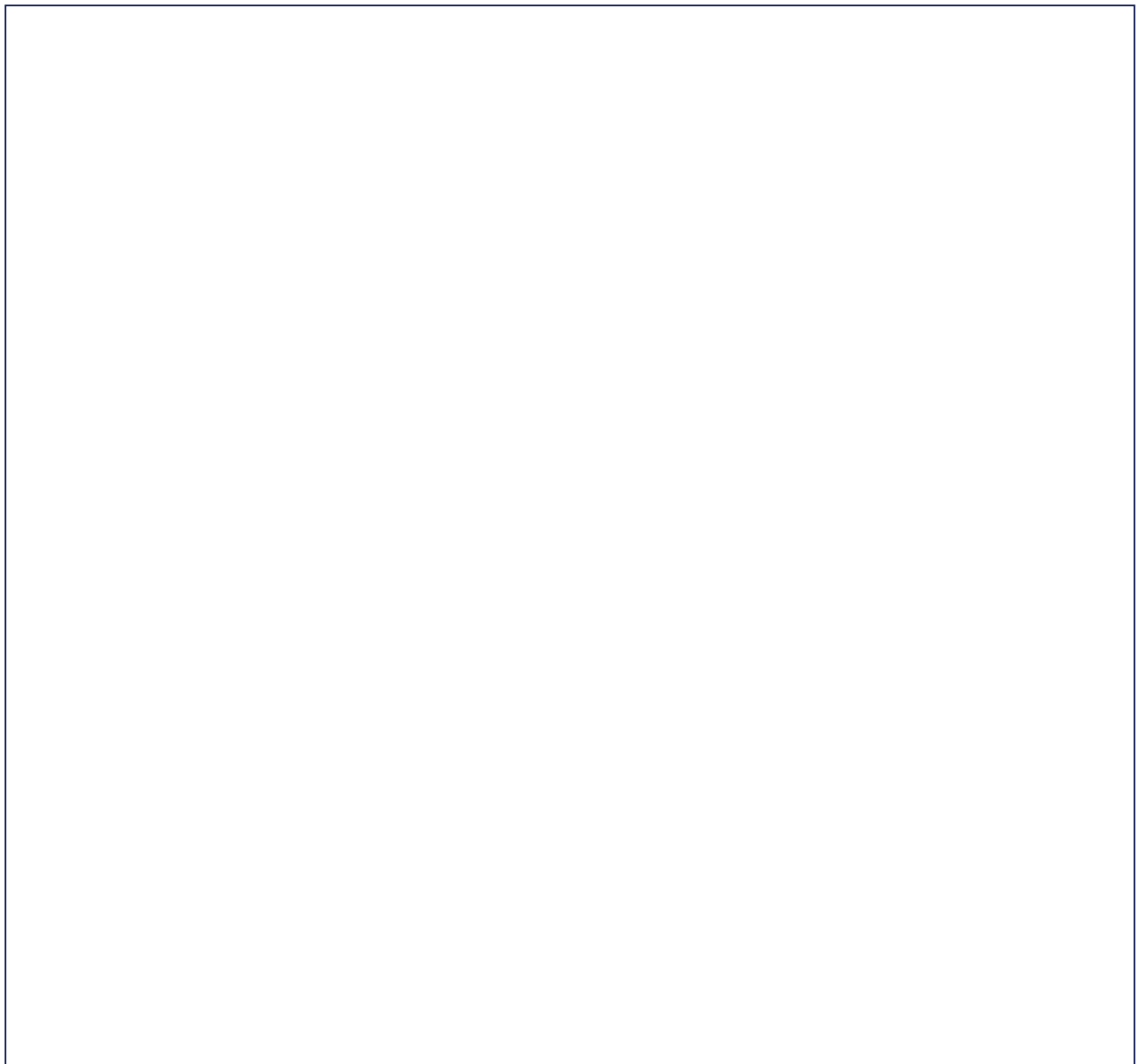


Nova's Seasonal Garden Adventure

Learning objective: To observe and identify the changes that happen across the four seasons.

Look at the four sections of the garden. Use your best colouring pencils to bring the seasons to life. Can you spot Nova the owl hiding in the trees?

Colour this: A large circular scene divided into four equal 'pizza slice' quadrants. Each quadrant represents a season. Top left (Spring): A tree with small green buds and a few spring flowers like daffodils on the grass. Top right (Summer): A bright sun in the corner, a tree with full green leaves, and colourful flowers. Bottom right (Autumn): A tree with orange and brown leaves falling to the ground, and a squirrel nearby. Bottom left (Winter): A bare tree with no leaves, a few snowflakes in the air, and a small snowman. Nova the owl is perched on a branch in the centre of the tree trunks, wearing a little scarf. The outlines should be thick and bold for easy colouring.



Steps:

1. Label the tree that has colourful autumn leaves.

2. Label the season where you might see a snowman.
3. Label the sun in the summer section of the picture.
