

Nova's Springtime Science Adventure

Learning objective: To observe and identify the signs of spring and understand the life cycle of plants.

Help Nova the owl explore the garden! Read the questions carefully and talk to your grown-up about what you see in the world around you during spring.

Word bank: Spring · Seed · Flower · Warm · Rain · Grow

1. Nova sees a tiny seed in the soil. What two things does the seed need to help it grow into a flower? (2 marks)

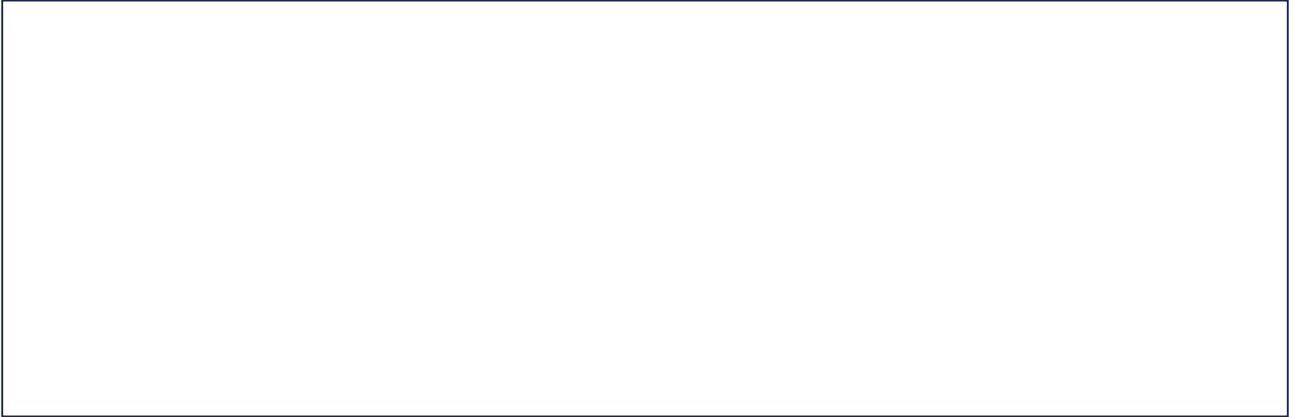
2. In spring, the weather starts to change. Is it usually colder or warmer than in winter? (1 mark)

3. Name one animal you might see waking up or coming out more often when spring arrives. (1 mark)

4. Look at the word bank. Which word describes the new season when the plants start to grow again? (1 mark)

5. If a packet of sunflower seeds costs £1, and you have a £2 coin, how much change would you get back? (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of a garden in spring. Include a bright yellow sun, a green sprout coming out of the dirt, and one animal you think enjoys the spring sunshine.



Extension challenge: Go on a 'Spring Walk' with your family. Can you find three different coloured flowers? Tell a friend or teacher what colours they are.
