

# Bea's Brilliant Teeth Worksheet

*Learning objective: To identify the different types of human teeth and their functions.*

Hello! I am Bea the honeybee. Look at the pictures of teeth below and use the word bank to help you answer these questions. Use the sentence starters to help you write your answers.

Humans have different teeth to help us eat. Incisors are sharp for biting. Canines are pointed for tearing food. Molars are flat and wide for grinding food down.

*Word bank: Incisors · Canines · Molars · Biting · Tearing · Grinding*

**1. Which teeth are at the front of your mouth and are used for biting? Sentence starter: The teeth used for biting are the... (2 marks)**

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**2. Which teeth are sharp and pointed to help with tearing food? Sentence starter: The sharp teeth used for tearing are the... (2 marks)**

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**3. Which teeth are wide and flat for grinding food? Sentence starter: The flat teeth used for grinding are the... (2 marks)**

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**4. Why do we need different shapes of teeth? Sentence starter: We need different teeth because we eat... (3 marks)**

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**Draw: Draw a set of human teeth. Label the front teeth as Incisors and the back teeth as Molars.**
