

Rosa the Parrot's Spanish Animal Quiz

Learning objective: To identify and describe animals in Spanish and use simple sentences to express likes and dislikes.

Read each question carefully. Use the word bank to help you spell the Spanish words correctly. Write your answers on the lines provided.

Hola! I am Rosa the parrot. I love learning new words. Today we are looking at animals. Some animals are big and some are small. Look at the pictures and words to help you answer the questions.

Word bank: el perro (dog) · el gato (cat) · el conejo (rabbit) · el pájaro (bird) · me gusta (I like) · no me gusta (I do not like) · grande (big) · pequeño (small)

1. Look at the picture of a dog. Write the Spanish name for 'dog' below. (2 marks)

2. Write the Spanish name for 'cat' and 'rabbit'. (4 marks)

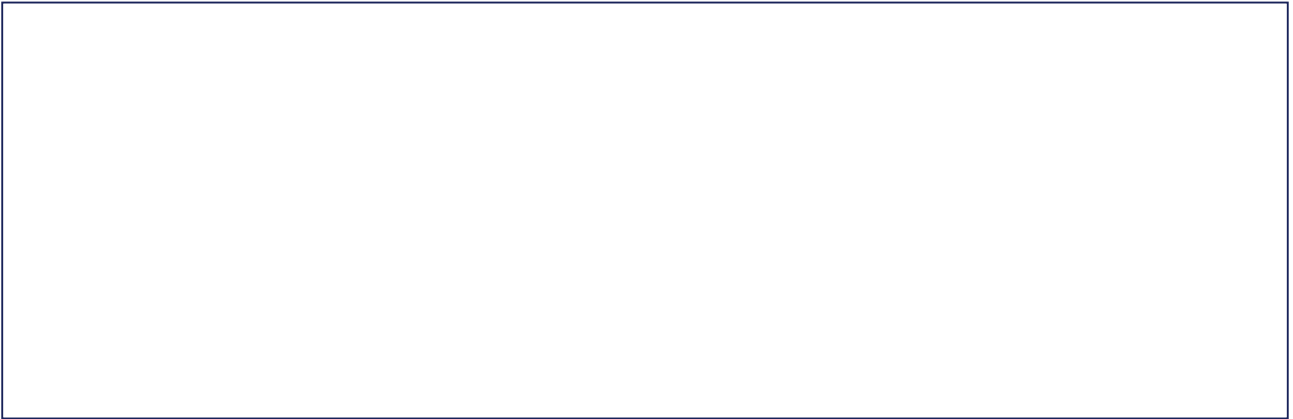
3. If a bird is small, we say 'es pequeño'. How would you write 'The bird is small' in Spanish? (4 marks)

4. Use 'me gusta' or 'no me gusta' to write a sentence about an animal you like or dislike. Example: Me gusta el gato. (5 marks)

5. Rosa has a friend. If the friend says 'El perro es grande', what does that mean in English? (5 marks)

6. Fill in the blank: 'El _____ es pequeño' (The rabbit is small). (5 marks)

Draw: In the box below, draw your favourite animal and write its name in Spanish underneath.
