

Rosa's Spanish Clothes Wardrobe

Learning objective: To learn and identify common items of clothing in Spanish.

Rosa the parrot is getting ready for a sunny day out. Look at the Spanish words for clothes in the box below. Draw a line to match each Spanish word to the correct picture of the clothing item. Then, write the Spanish word on the line next to the item.

Word bank: una camiseta (t-shirt) · unos pantalones (trousers) · un sombrero (hat) · unos zapatos (shoes) · una chaqueta (jacket)

1. 1. Look at the picture of the T-shirt. Write the Spanish word here: (2 marks)

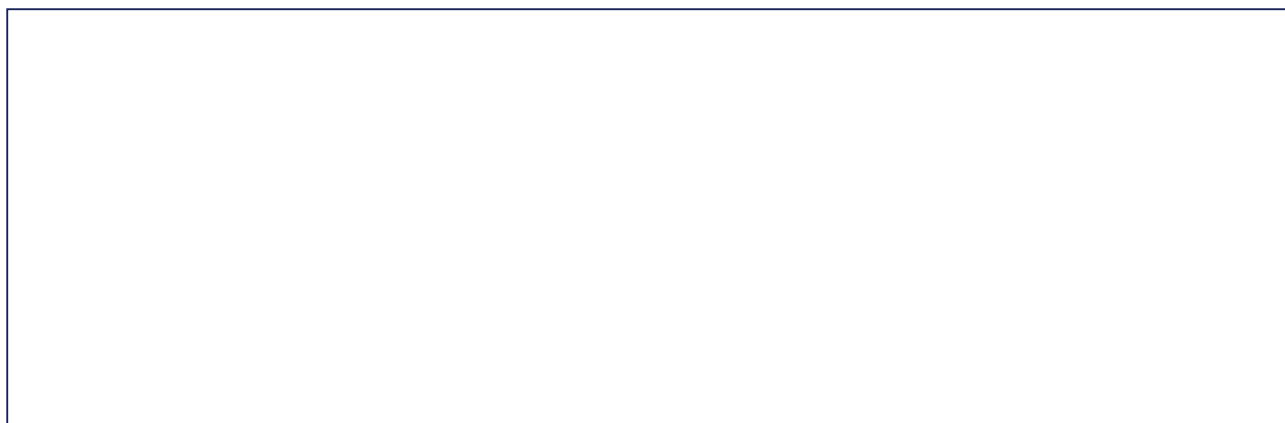
2. 2. Look at the picture of the trousers. Write the Spanish word here: (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of Rosa the parrot wearing a colourful hat and a jacket. Label the hat 'un sombrero' and the jacket 'una chaqueta'.
