

Rosa's Spanish Clothes Check

Learning objective: To identify and write Spanish vocabulary for common items of clothing.

Hello! I am Rosa the parrot. Let's practise our Spanish clothes words. Read the questions carefully. Use the word bank at the bottom to help you spell the words correctly.

Rosa is getting ready for a sunny walk. She chooses her favourite outfit. She puts on her blue trousers, a red t-shirt, and her big hat to stay cool in the sun.

Word bank: la camiseta (t-shirt) · los pantalones (trousers) · los zapatos (shoes) · el sombrero (hat) · la chaqueta (jacket)

2. Translate these words into Spanish: 1. Trousers = _____ 2. T-shirt = _____ (4 marks)

3. If it is cold, would you wear a jacket? Write 'Yes' or 'No' in Spanish and the word for jacket. (4 marks)

4. Complete the sentence using the word bank: Rosa wears _____ to walk. (3 marks)

5. Imagine you are going on a trip with Rosa. Write 3 sentences in Spanish describing what you are wearing. Use: 'Yo llevo...' (I am wearing...) (7 marks)

Draw: Draw yourself wearing your favourite outfit. Label two of the items in Spanish.
