

Rosa's Wardrobe

Learning objective: To read and understand simple Spanish phrases about clothes and describe what someone is wearing.

Read the story about Rosa the parrot below. Use the word bank to help you understand the Spanish words. Answer the questions in the boxes provided.

Rosa is a colourful parrot who loves to dress up. Today, she is getting ready for a party in the jungle. Rosa looks in her mirror and says, '¡Hola!' She picks out her favourite clothes. First, she puts on a bright red t-shirt, which is 'una camiseta roja' in Spanish. Next, she chooses her long blue trousers, or 'los pantalones azules'. Rosa wants to look very smart, so she adds a fancy hat. She says, '¡Me gusta mi sombrero!' which means 'I like my hat!' Finally, she puts on her comfortable shoes. Rosa is very happy with her outfit. She looks at her reflection and smiles. 'Hoy llevo una camiseta roja, pantalones azules y un sombrero,' she says. Rosa is ready to dance and sing with all her friends. She loves learning new words for her clothes. It is fun to speak Spanish every day!

Word bank: la camiseta - the t-shirt · los pantalones - the trousers · los zapatos - the shoes · el sombrero - the hat · rojo - red · azul - blue · llevo - I am wearing

1. 1. What colour is Rosa's t-shirt? (Look for the Spanish word for red). (2 marks)

2. 2. List two items of clothing that Rosa puts on in the story. (2 marks)

3. 3. Why does Rosa put on a hat? Use the text to help you. (2 marks)

4. 4. Rosa says '¡Me gusta mi sombrero!' What does this tell us about how she feels? (2 marks)

5. 5. If you were going to a party, what would you choose to wear? Why? (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of Rosa the parrot wearing her red t-shirt, blue trousers, and her fancy hat.



Extension challenge: Can you draw your own outfit and label two items of clothing in Spanish using the word bank?
