

Rosa's Wardrobe Adventure: Una Aventura de Ropa

Learning objective: To identify, label, and use Spanish vocabulary for items of clothing accurately within a creative drawing context.

Help Rosa the parrot get ready for her travels! Use the word bank to label the items of clothing in your drawing. Make sure your labels are clearly written in Spanish.

Draw: Draw a scene featuring Rosa the parrot standing in front of an open suitcase. Around her, illustrate at least four different items of clothing from the word bank. Use vibrant colours and clear outlines. You may add extra details like a travel map or a pair of sunglasses to show where she is going.



Label words: la camiseta (t-shirt) · los pantalones (trousers) · el sombrero (hat) · los zapatos (shoes) · el vestido (dress) · la chaqueta (jacket)

Steps:

1. Label Rosa's outfit using at least four words from the word bank. Ensure the articles (el/la/los) are included.
2. Compare and contrast: If Rosa travels to a snowy mountain compared to a sunny beach, which items from your drawing would she change? Justify your choice.
3. Explain why it is important to use the correct gender (el/la) when learning Spanish vocabulary for clothes.
