

Rosa's Spanish Clothes Wardrobe

Learning objective: To learn and identify Spanish vocabulary for common items of clothing.

Rosa the parrot is getting ready for a sunny day! Use the word bank to help you answer the questions. Look at the pictures or use the words to fill in the gaps.

Word bank: la camiseta (t-shirt) · los pantalones (trousers) · los zapatos (shoes) · el sombrero (hat) · el vestido (dress)

1. Rosa wants to wear a t-shirt. Write the Spanish word for t-shirt here: (1 mark)

2. If Rosa puts on her hat, she is wearing an _____. (1 mark)

3. Match the Spanish word to the English word by drawing a line:

Los pantalones --- Shoes

Los zapatos --- Trousers (2 marks)

4. Rosa has £10. A dress costs £8. Does she have enough money? Write 'Sí' or 'No' and explain why. (2 marks)

5. Complete the sentence: 'Yo llevo...' (I am wearing) and choose one item from the word bank to finish the sentence. (1 mark)

Draw: Draw Rosa the parrot wearing a hat (el sombrero) and a t-shirt (la camiseta). Label your drawing with the Spanish words.
