

Rosa's Colourful Garden

Learning objective: To identify and use basic Spanish colour vocabulary to describe objects in a scene.

Rosa the parrot is painting a garden! Follow the steps below to help her finish the picture. Use the word bank to label your drawings in Spanish.

Draw: Draw a sunny garden scene on the empty space below. Include a big flower, a shining sun, two green leaves, and a butterfly. Colour each item exactly as the instructions tell you, then write the correct Spanish colour label next to each item.



Label words: rojo (red) · azul (blue) · amarillo (yellow) · verde (green) · naranja (orange) · morado (purple)

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a large flower and colour it 'rojo'. Write the Spanish word next to it.
2. Step 2: Draw a bright sun and colour it 'amarillo'. Write the Spanish word next to it.
3. Step 3: Draw two leaves on your flower and colour them 'verde'. Write the Spanish word next to them.
4. Step 4: Draw a butterfly in the sky and colour it 'azul'. Write the Spanish word next to it.
