

Rosa's Rainbow: Learn Spanish Colours

Join Rosa the Parrot on a colourful adventure—¡Vamos! Let's learn to name the colours in Spanish.

- Rojo is the word for the colour of a bright red strawberry.
- Azul is the word for the colour of the deep, wide ocean.
- Amarillo is the word for the colour of a glowing, warm sun.
- Verde is the word for the colour of fresh leaves on a tree.
- Naranja is the word for the colour of a juicy, round fruit.
- Morado is the word for the colour of lovely, soft lavender flowers.

Did you know? Did you know? In Spanish, most colour words change their ending to match the noun they describe! For example, a red apple is 'una manzana roja', but a red book is 'un libro rojo'.
