

Rosa's Colourful Spanish Garden

Learning objective: To learn and use basic colour names in Spanish.

Read the sentences about Rosa the parrot's garden. Match the Spanish words to the English meanings. Write your answers on the lines provided.

Rosa the parrot loves her garden. She sees a bright rojo apple. She looks at the sky which is azul. She spots a sunny amarillo flower. She hides in the tall verde grass. She eats a crunchy naranja carrot.

Word bank: rojo - red · azul - blue · amarillo - yellow · verde - green · naranja - orange

1. What is the Spanish word for the colour of the apple in the story? (1 mark)

2. The sky is blue. Write the Spanish word for blue here: (1 mark)

3. The grass is green. Write the Spanish word for green here: (1 mark)

4. Rosa sees a flower that is yellow. Write the Spanish word for yellow here: (1 mark)

5. Which colour is the carrot in Spanish? (1 mark)

Draw: Draw a picture of Rosa the parrot sitting in the garden. Draw a red apple, a blue sky, a yellow flower, green grass, and an orange carrot. Label each item with its Spanish name.



Extension challenge: Can you ask a friend: '¿Qué color es este?' (What colour is this?) and point to something in the classroom to test them?
