

Rosa's Rainbow Art Gallery: My Spanish Colour Palette

Learning objective: To identify and use common Spanish colour vocabulary to describe objects in the environment.

Rosa the parrot is helping us learn how to describe the world in Spanish! Use this template to create your own colour-themed fact-file. Choose five different objects you can see around you, write down what they are in English, and find the correct Spanish word for their colour from the word bank to complete your descriptions.

Word bank: rojo (red) · azul (blue) · amarillo (yellow) · verde (green) · naranja (orange) · morado (purple) · rosa (pink) · blanco (white) · negro (black) · marrón (brown)

1. Object 1: Describe an object you see. Write a sentence in Spanish using the format: 'El/La [object name] es [colour].' (2 marks)

2. Object 2: Choose an object of a different colour. Write a sentence in Spanish to describe it. (2 marks)

3. Object 3: Choose an object that is either 'rojo' or 'verde'. Write a sentence in Spanish to describe it. (2 marks)

4. Object 4: Choose an object that is 'amarillo' or 'azul'. Write a sentence in Spanish to describe it. (2 marks)

5. Object 5: Pick your favourite colour from the list. Write a sentence in Spanish describing an object that is that colour. (2 marks)

Extension challenge: Challenge: Can you write a short paragraph in Spanish describing the colours of a sunset or a garden, using at least four different colour words from our word bank?
