2. 2. If today is Monday (lunes), what is the Spanish word for tomorrow (Tuesday)? (2 marks)

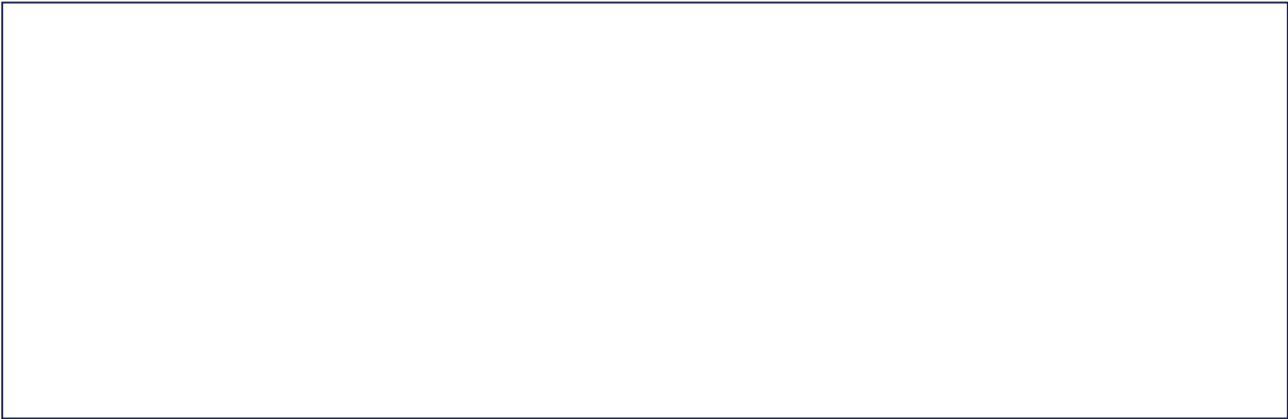
3. 3. Match the English day to the Spanish day by drawing a line or writing the correct pair:
