

Rosa the Parrot's Busy Week

Learning objective: To learn and identify the days of the week in Spanish.

Read the story about Rosa. Look at the Spanish words for the days. Use the word bank to help you answer the questions below.

Rosa is a colourful parrot who loves to teach. Every week, she follows a busy plan. On lunes, she reads books. On martes, she practises her singing. On miércoles, she helps her friends learn new words. Rosa goes to the forest school on jueves to share stories. When viernes arrives, she is very happy because it is almost the weekend. On sábado, Rosa flies high in the sky to see the clouds. She loves to rest on domingo. Rosa thinks that having a plan makes every week exciting. She says, 'Knowing the days helps me stay organised!' Whether it is a school day or a rest day, Rosa is always ready to learn something new. She hopes you have a wonderful week too. Rosa likes to use Spanish words to name each day. Practising these words helps her brain grow strong. She is a very clever parrot who enjoys being busy from start to finish.

1. On which day does Rosa go to the forest school? (2 marks)

2. What does Rosa do on sábado? (2 marks)

3. Why is Rosa happy when viernes arrives? (2 marks)

4. How does Rosa feel about having a weekly plan? (2 marks)

5. Which day of the week is your favourite and why? (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of Rosa the parrot holding a sign that shows your favourite day of the week in Spanish.



Extension challenge: Try to write a sentence in Spanish about what you do on a Saturday. For example: 'El sábado, yo...'
