

¡Los Días de la Semana! With Rosa the Parrot

¡Hola! Join Rosa on a colourful journey to master the days of the week in Spanish!

- **Fact 1:** The Spanish word for Monday is 'lunes', which comes from the word 'Luna', meaning the Moon.
- **Fact 2:** 'Martes' is for Tuesday, 'miércoles' for Wednesday, and 'jueves' for Thursday.
- **Fact 3:** 'Viernes' is the Spanish word for Friday, often the most exciting day for school children!
- **Fact 4:** The weekend consists of 'sábado' (Saturday) and 'domingo' (Sunday).
- **Fact 5:** When asking what day it is, we say: '¿Qué día es hoy?'

Did you know? Did you know? In Spanish, the days of the week are not written with a capital letter at the start, unlike in English! Also, the week in Spain traditionally starts on a Monday (lunes), which is why our list begins there.
