

Rosa's Spanish Days of the Week

Join Rosa the parrot and learn to say the days of the week in Spanish!

- **Lunes** is the Spanish word for Monday, the first day of the school week.
- **Martes, miércoles, and jueves** are the next three days of the week.
- **Viernes** is the final school day, which many people love because it is Friday!
- **Sábado and domingo** are the weekend days, perfect for resting and playing.
- **Remember:** Spanish days of the week always start with a lowercase letter.

Did you know? Did you know? In Spanish, the days of the week are not written with a capital letter at the start unless they begin a sentence. Also, the names of the days come from the names of planets and the moon!
