

Rosa's Spanish Days of the Week

Learning objective: To learn the names of the days of the week in Spanish.

Read the sentences about what Rosa the parrot does each day. Use the word bank to help you match the Spanish words to the English days. Write your answers clearly on the lines.

Rosa the parrot loves to teach! On lunes, she reads a book. On martes, she flies in the sun. On miércoles, she eats a crunchy apple. On jueves, she sings a happy song. On viernes, she practises her dance. On sábado, she visits her friends. On domingo, she rests in her nest.

Word bank: lunes (Monday) · martes (Tuesday) · miércoles (Wednesday) · jueves (Thursday) · viernes (Friday) · sábado (Saturday) · domingo (Sunday)

1. Rosa reads a book on Monday. How do you say Monday in Spanish? (1 mark)

2. Rosa sings a song on Thursday. How do you say Thursday in Spanish? (1 mark)

3. Rosa visits her friends on Saturday. How do you say Saturday in Spanish? (1 mark)

4. Rosa rests in her nest on Sunday. How do you say Sunday in Spanish? (1 mark)

Draw: Draw a picture of Rosa the parrot doing your favourite activity. Write the Spanish word for the day you would do this activity at the top of your drawing.
