Learning objective: To recall and spell the days of the week in Spanish and understand their order.

Join Rosa the parrot for a quick Spanish challenge! Read each question carefully and choose the correct answer. Remember, in Spanish, days of the week do not start with a capital letter unless they are at the start of a sentence.

8. 8. True or False: 'martes' is the Spanish word for Monday. (1 mark)

9. 9. True or False: The word 'viernes' starts with a 'v'. (1 mark)

10. 10. If today is 'domingo', what day is tomorrow in Spanish? (1 mark)

Draw: Draw a colourful calendar for the week. Label each of the seven boxes with the correct Spanish day of the week and draw a small picture to represent what you might do on that day (e.g., a book for reading on lunes).
