

Rosa's Spanish Food Fiesta: Year 4 Assessment

Learning objective: To demonstrate understanding of Spanish food vocabulary, preferences, and sentence structure.

Read each question carefully. Write your answers in English or Spanish as requested. Ensure your spelling is accurate.

Rosa the parrot is visiting a local market. She sees a stall selling fresh bread, round red apples, and creamy cheese. She says, '¡Buenos días! Me gusta el queso, pero no me gusta la leche.'

Word bank: el desayuno (breakfast) · el almuerzo (lunch) · la cena (dinner) · me gusta (I like) · no me gusta (I do not like) · la manzana (apple) · el pan (bread) · la leche (milk) · el queso (cheese) · los huevos (eggs) · delicioso (delicious) · saludable (healthy)

1. Translate the following sentence into English: 'Me gusta la manzana.' (1 mark)

2. Using the word bank, write a sentence explaining one food you like and one food you do not like in Spanish. (2 marks)

3. Rosa wants to buy three items at the market. A loaf of bread costs £1.20, an apple costs £0.40, and a piece of cheese costs £2.50. How much is the total cost in pounds and pence? (2 marks)

4. Explain why it is important to include a variety of food groups in our daily meals. Refer to the concept of a 'saludable' diet. (3 marks)

5. Compare and contrast the typical British breakfast with the vocabulary learned in this unit. What are the similarities and differences? (4 marks)

6. Justify your answer: If you were hosting a Spanish dinner party, which three items from the word bank would you choose to serve and why? (4 marks)

7. Extended Writing Task: Rosa is writing a menu for her friends. Write a short paragraph in Spanish (using English for descriptions) describing a balanced meal for 'el almuerzo'. Include at least four food items and explain why they are delicious. (5 marks)

8. What might happen if someone only ate one type of food every day? Predict the impact on their health. (4 marks)

Draw: Draw a colourful 'plato saludable' (healthy plate) featuring at least three of the food items from our word bank. Label them in Spanish.



Extension challenge: Imagine you are a chef. Create a new, original Spanish dish recipe using at least three ingredients. Give your dish a creative name and write a persuasive paragraph to convince Rosa to try it. Total: /25
