

Rosa the Parrot's Spanish Food Quiz

Learning objective: To identify and use basic Spanish vocabulary for food and drink.

Read each question carefully. Use the word bank to help you write your answers. Write clearly in the spaces provided.

Rosa the parrot is having a picnic in the park! She has many tasty things to eat and drink. She wants to share them with her friends.

Word bank: la manzana (apple) · el agua (water) · la leche (milk) · la naranja (orange) · el pan (bread) · el queso (cheese) · la pizza (pizza) · me gusta (I like) · no me gusta (I do not like)

1. Rosa has a piece of bread. How do you say 'bread' in Spanish? (2 marks)

2. Rosa has a drink. How do you say 'water' in Spanish? (2 marks)

3. If Rosa likes cheese, how would she say 'I like cheese' in Spanish? (4 marks)

4. Rosa has an apple and an orange. Write the Spanish words for both fruits. (4 marks)

5. Rosa goes to the shop to buy a pizza. It costs £4. Write the sentence 'I like pizza' in Spanish. (3 marks)

6. Imagine you are at a picnic with Rosa. Write five short sentences about what you like to eat or drink using 'Me gusta...' or 'No me gusta...'. (10 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of your favourite snack on a picnic plate. Label the snack using the Spanish word from the word bank.
