

Rosa's Spanish Food Feast

Learning objective: To learn and use Spanish vocabulary for common food and drink items.

Help Rosa the parrot learn her favourite snacks! Look at the Spanish words and write the English meaning. Use the word bank to help you.

Word bank: la manzana - apple · el plátano - banana · el pan - bread · el agua - water · la leche - milk · el queso - cheese

1. Rosa is hungry! How do you say 'the apple' in Spanish? (1 mark)

2. Max the monkey wants a snack. Write the Spanish word for 'bread'. (1 mark)

3. If you are thirsty, you might want 'el agua'. What does this mean in English? (1 mark)

4. Match the word to the item: Draw a line from 'el plátano' to the correct fruit. (2 marks)

5. Complete the sentence: 'Me gusta...' (I like...) Choose one food from the word bank and write it in the gap. (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of a picnic basket. Inside, draw an apple (la manzana) and a banana (el plátano). Label them in Spanish.



Extension challenge: Can you ask a friend '¿Te gusta el queso?' (Do you like cheese?) and write down their answer as 'Sí' (Yes) or 'No'.
