

Rosa the Parrot's Spanish Greetings

Learning objective: To learn and use basic Spanish greetings and introductions.

Rosa the parrot is visiting a new forest. She wants to say hello to her friends! Look at the Spanish words in the word bank. Match the Spanish greeting to the correct English meaning by drawing a line between them.

Word bank: Hola - Hello · Buenos días - Good morning · Adiós - Goodbye · ¿Cómo te llamas? - What is your name? · Me llamo... - My name is...

2. 2. Write the Spanish words to say 'Hello'. (1 mark)

3. 3. Complete this sentence to tell Rosa your name: 'Me llamo _____. ' (1 mark)

4. 4. If you are leaving the forest, what do you say to your friends? (1 mark)

Draw: Draw a picture of Rosa the parrot waving at her friends in the forest. Label your drawing with the word 'Hola!'
