

Spanish Greetings Assessment: With Rosa the Parrot

Learning objective: To greet people in Spanish and ask how they are feeling.

Read each question carefully. Use the word bank to help you spell the Spanish words correctly. Write your answers on the lines provided.

Rosa the parrot is flying through the trees. She meets her friends and wants to say hello. She also wants to know how they are feeling today.

Word bank: Hola · Adiós · Buenos días · Buenas tardes · ¿Cómo estás? · Muy bien · Gracias

1. Rosa sees a friend in the morning. What does she say to greet them? (Write it in Spanish) (2 marks)

2. Rosa asks her friend how they are. Write the Spanish question for 'How are you?'. (2 marks)

3. Her friend replies that they are doing very well. Write this in Spanish. (2 marks)

4. Rosa is leaving the forest. Write the Spanish word for 'Goodbye'. (2 marks)

5. Rosa meets a new friend. Write a short conversation (3 sentences) in Spanish using the words you know. You can use: Hello, How are you?, I am fine, Thank you, Goodbye. (5 marks)

6. Match these times to the correct greeting by drawing a line or writing the pair: (A) Morning = _____, (B) Afternoon = _____. (4 marks)

7. Why is it polite to say 'Gracias' after someone asks how you are? (8 marks)
