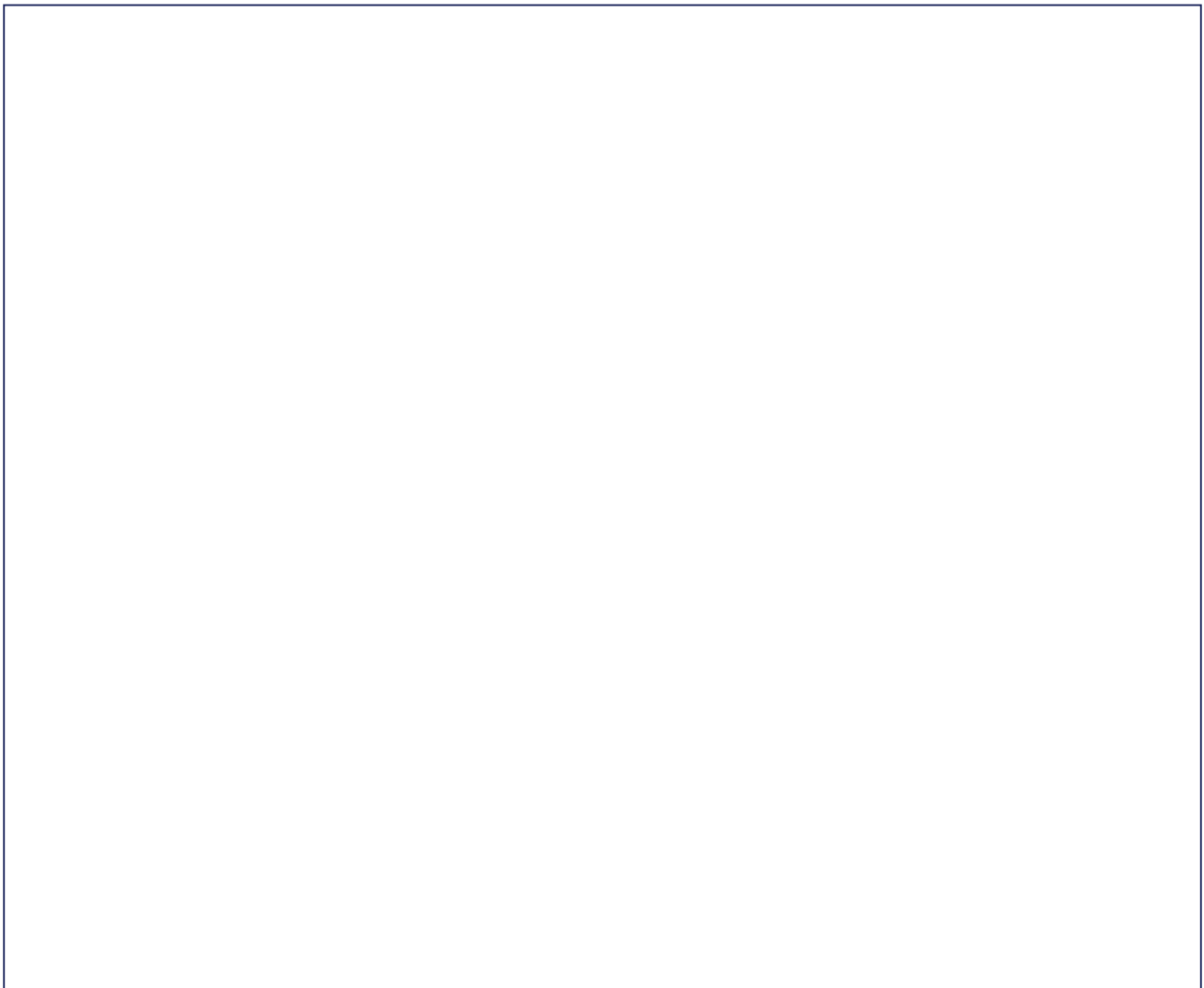


Rosa's Spanish Greeting Garden

Learning objective: To learn and use basic Spanish greetings and respond to them.

Follow the steps below to draw your Spanish garden scene. Add the Spanish labels to the speech bubbles to help Rosa the parrot practice her greetings.

Draw: Draw a sunny garden scene featuring Rosa the parrot sitting on a tree branch. Include a bright yellow sun in the sky, a large colourful flower on the ground, and a winding path leading to a gate. Leave space near each object for a speech bubble where the student will write the Spanish greeting.



Label words: Hola · Buenos días · Adiós · Gracias

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw Rosa the parrot on a branch. Draw a speech bubble next to her. Write 'Hola' in it to say hello.
2. Step 2: Draw a bright yellow sun in the corner. Draw a speech bubble under the sun. Write 'Buenos días' to say good morning.
3. Step 3: Draw a pretty flower. Draw a speech bubble above the flower. Write 'Gracias' to say thank you.
4. Step 4: Draw a path leading away from the garden. Draw a speech bubble at the end of the path. Write 'Adiós' to say goodbye.
