

Rosa the Parrot's Spanish Greetings

Learning objective: To learn and use basic Spanish greetings.

Read the sentences below with Rosa the parrot. Use the word bank to help you answer the questions. Follow the sentence starters to help you write.

Rosa the parrot is very friendly. She loves to speak Spanish with her friends! Every morning, she says 'Buenos días' to the sun. When she meets a new friend, she says 'Hola'. She always asks, '¿Cómo estás?' to see if they are happy. When it is time to fly away, she says 'Adiós'.

Word bank: Hola · Buenos días · Adiós · ¿Cómo estás? · Bien, gracias

1. What does Rosa say when she meets a new friend? Start your answer with: Rosa says... (2 marks)

2. How do you say 'Good morning' in Spanish? Start your answer with: In Spanish, it is... (2 marks)

3. If Rosa asks you '¿Cómo estás?', what could you say back? Start your answer with: I would say... (2 marks)

4. What do you say when you leave a friend? Start your answer with: You say... (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of Rosa the parrot flying in the sky. Write the word 'Hola' inside a speech bubble next to her beak.
