

Spanish Hobbies Assessment: Year 4

Learning objective: To identify and write about hobbies in Spanish using 'Me gusta' and 'No me gusta'.

Read each question carefully. Use the word bank to help you spell your answers. Write your answers on the lines provided.

Rosa the parrot is visiting the park. She sees her friends doing their favourite hobbies. She says: '¡Hola! I love to learn what everyone likes to do!'

Word bank: leer (to read) · jugar al fútbol (to play football) · nadar (to swim) · dibujar (to draw) · escuchar música (to listen to music) · Me gusta (I like) · No me gusta (I do not like)

1. Rosa likes to draw. Write the Spanish phrase for 'I like to draw' using the word bank. (2 marks)

2. Max does not like to swim. Write the Spanish phrase for 'I do not like to swim'. (2 marks)

3. Look at the word bank. Choose two hobbies and write a sentence for each to say what you like. (4 marks)

4. Rosa asks: '¿Qué te gusta hacer?' (What do you like to do?). Write two sentences: one about a hobby you like and one about a hobby you do not like. (6 marks)

5. Extended Writing: Write a short paragraph (3-4 sentences) describing what you like to do in your spare time. Use 'Me gusta' and 'No me gusta' to describe your hobbies. (11 marks)

Draw: Draw yourself doing your favourite hobby. Label your hobby in Spanish.
