

Rosa's Hobbies Drawing Sheet

Learning objective: To learn and use Spanish vocabulary for hobbies (los pasatiempos) through drawing and labelling.

Follow the steps to create your own hobby scene. Use the word bank to label your pictures in Spanish. You can use colours to make your drawing bright!

Draw: Draw a large scene showing yourself doing two different hobbies. Use a colourful, cartoon style. Include yourself, a friend or pet, and objects related to the hobbies (like a ball for football or a book for reading). Make sure to leave space next to each activity to write the Spanish label.



Label words: leer (to read) · dibujar (to draw) · jugar al fútbol (to play football) · nadar (to swim) · escuchar música (to listen to music)

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw yourself doing your favourite hobby in the big box. What are you doing?
2. Step 2: Label your drawing using a word from the word bank. Write the Spanish word here:
3. Step 3: Draw another hobby you enjoy next to the first one. Write the Spanish word for it here:
4. Step 4: Who are you doing these hobbies with? Draw them in your scene and label them (e.g., 'mi amigo' for my friend).
