Learning objective: To recall and use Spanish vocabulary related to hobbies and interests, and to express personal preferences using simple structures.

6. If Finn is in the ocean, which hobby is he doing? A) nadar* B) bailar C) leer D) dibujar (1 mark)

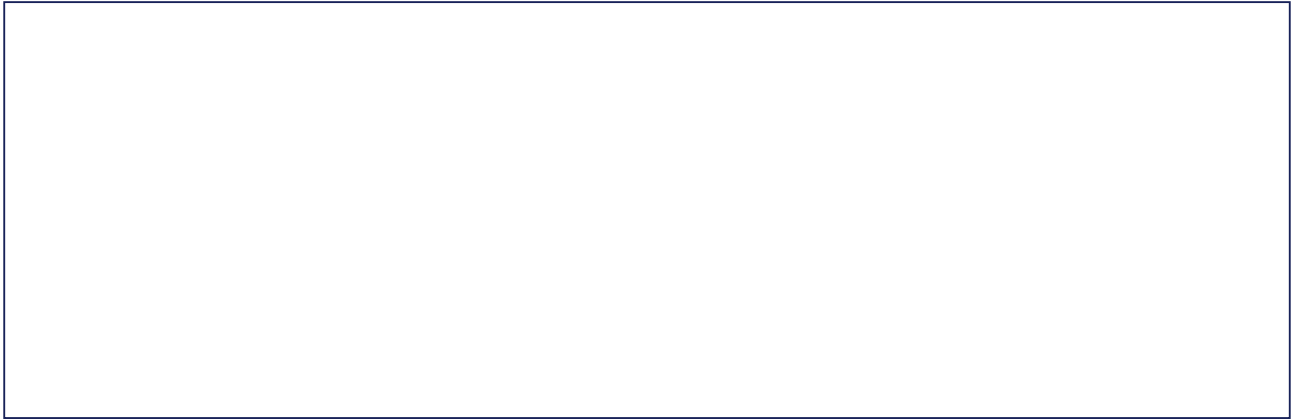
7. True or False: 'Escuchar música' means to listen to music. (1 mark)

Justify your answer: If you wanted to describe a hobby that involves movement and rhythm, which Spanish verb would you choose and why? 4. What might happen if you used the phrase 'No me gusta' when someone offers you a hobby you have never tried before? 5. If you were to create a new hobby, how would you describe it in Spanish using the vocabulary you have learned? 6. Analyse the importance of learning hobbies in a different language; how does this help us understand different cultures?
