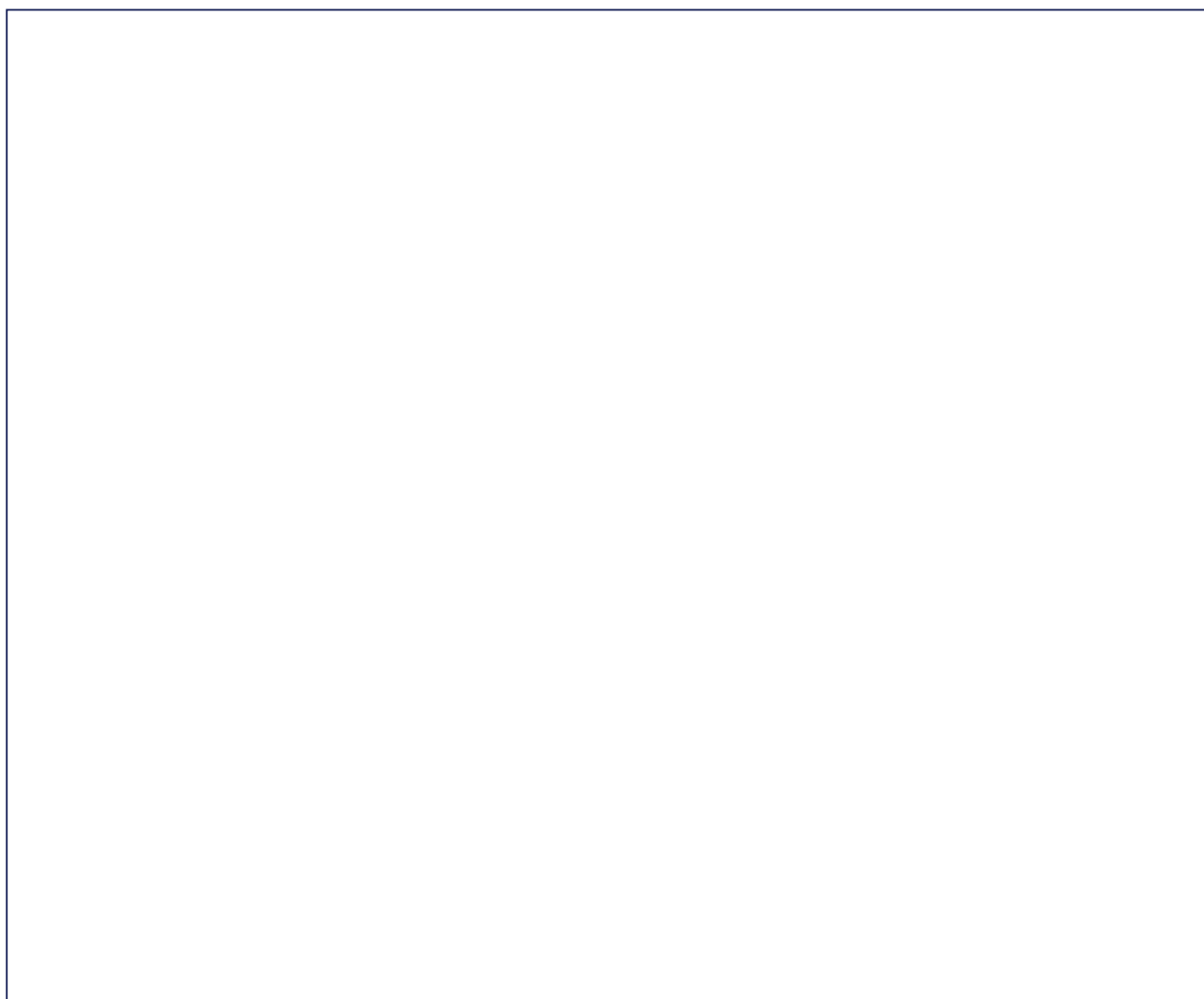


Rosa's Hobbies Art Challenge

Learning objective: To identify and use Spanish vocabulary related to hobbies and interests.

Follow the drawing prompt below to create your own 'Hobbies Scene'. Once your drawing is complete, label your items using the Spanish words from the word bank. Finally, answer the questions to show what you have learnt about describing hobbies in Spanish.

Draw: Draw a vibrant scene showing at least four different hobbies from the word bank. You could draw a park, a bedroom, or a swimming pool. Use bright colours and clear lines. Once the scene is finished, draw arrows pointing to each activity and label them with the correct Spanish phrase from the word bank provided.



Label words: jugar al fútbol (playing football) · leer libros (reading books) · montar en bicicleta (riding a bike) · escuchar música (listening to music) · dibujar (drawing) · nadar (swimming)

Steps:

1. Write a full sentence in Spanish to say what your favourite hobby is. (Example: Mi pasatiempo favorito es...)
2. If you wanted to ask a friend 'What do you like to do?', what Spanish phrase would you use?
3. Translate the phrase 'I like to swim' into Spanish.
4. Look at your drawing. Which hobby from your word bank would involve being outdoors? Write the Spanish

phrase below.

5. Why is it useful to know how to talk about hobbies when meeting someone new?
