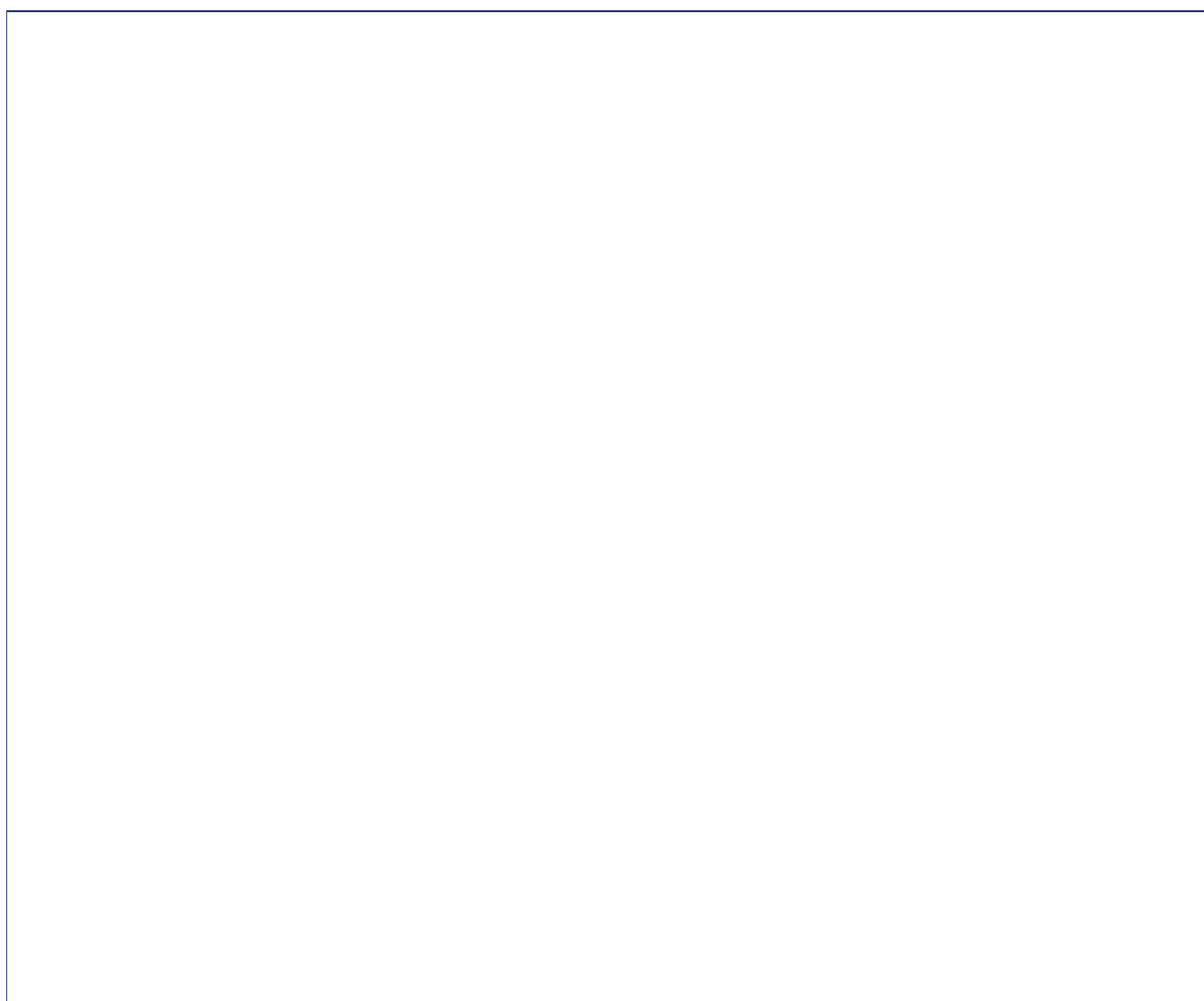


Rosa's Seasonal Calendar Drawing Sheet

Learning objective: To identify and spell the months of the year in Spanish and represent them visually through seasonal illustration.

Rosa the parrot wants to create a colourful calendar to help her remember the months of the year in Spanish. Follow the instructions below to complete your seasonal wheel.

Draw: Draw a large circle divided into 12 equal segments, like a pizza. In each segment, write one of the Spanish months from the word bank in the correct chronological order starting with 'enero' at the top. In each segment, draw a small, detailed picture that represents the typical weather or an event associated with that month in the UK (e.g., flowers for 'abril', snow for 'diciembre', or sunshine for 'agosto'). Use vibrant colours to show the change of seasons as you move around the circle.



Label words: enero · febrero · marzo · abril · mayo · junio · julio · agosto · septiembre · octubre · noviembre · diciembre

Steps:

1. Choose two months that fall in the same season. Write them in Spanish and explain why you chose those specific colours to represent that season.
2. If Rosa is celebrating her birthday in 'julio', which season is it? Justify your answer by comparing the

weather in 'julio' to the weather in 'enero'.

3. Look at the word 'septiembre'. How is it similar to the English word for the ninth month? Why might it be easier to remember?
4. Explain why it is important for a calendar to be organised in a circular pattern rather than a straight line. What might happen if we didn't have months?
5. Compare and contrast the month 'mayo' with 'noviembre'. Describe the sensory differences you would include in your drawings for these two months.
6. If a friend claimed that 'octubre' comes before 'septiembre', how would you correct them using Spanish vocabulary?
