Learning objective: To learn and recognise Spanish numbers from 1 to 10.

Rosa the parrot wants to help you learn your Spanish numbers! Look at the Spanish number word in the list below. Draw a line to match the Spanish word to the correct digit. Then, use the word bank to help you fill in the missing letters for the number shown in the box.
