

Rosa's Spanish Number Garden

Learning objective: To learn and write Spanish numbers from 1 to 10 by drawing and labelling items.

Follow the steps below to draw a garden scene. Label each group of items with the correct Spanish word from the word bank. Use your best handwriting.

Draw: A peaceful garden scene. The style should be bright and colourful, like a friendly storybook illustration. Include a grassy meadow at the bottom and a clear blue sky at the top. Leave plenty of white space for the student to draw the requested items (sun, flowers, bees, leaves) clearly so they can add their labels next to them.



Label words: uno (1) · dos (2) · tres (3) · cuatro (4) · cinco (5) · seis (6) · siete (7) · ocho (8) · nueve (9) · diez (10)

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw 1 large yellow sun in the sky. Label it with the Spanish word for 1.
2. Step 2: Draw 3 red flowers in the grass. Label them with the Spanish word for 3.
3. Step 3: Draw 5 little bees buzzing near the flowers. Label them with the Spanish word for 5.
4. Step 4: Draw 10 green leaves on a tree. Label them with the Spanish word for 10.
